I. CALL TO ORDER – Open Public Hearing

1. This Public Hearing is regarding the proposed Application for the FY-2024 Orange County Community Development Block Grant Program.

The Village invites public comments and suggestions regarding projects to be considered for funding under the Orange County Community Development Block Grant Program. Under this Program a variety of physical improvements as listed below are eligible for funding: acquisition and disposition of real property; public works, public facilities or site improvements; code enforcement (housing and health codes); clearance, demolition and rehabilitation for public use or economic development; housing rehabilitation loan and grants; special projects for elderly and handicapped; provision of public services (shelter, clinics, senior nutrition, etc.); payment of non-federal shares of other grant programs; relocation payments and assistance. The Town/Village will be considering projects to be submitted to the Orange County Community Development Block Grant Program. The deadline for submittal is June 23, 2023.

The Village Board will at the above date, time and place hear all persons interested in the subject matter hereof. Persons may appear in person or by agent. All written communications addressed to the Board must be received by the Board at or prior to the public hearing which communications may be sent to the Clerk's office as follows:

Adopt a resolution, approving the Village of Montgomery to hereby submit its application for consideration under the FY-2024 orange urban consortium community development program authorizing Mayor Brescia/or Designee to submit this application. They further certify that they have read and understood the Orange Urban County Consortium Community development guidelines for the FY 2024 program year, and have met all of its applicable requirements and that the information contained in the application is accurate and true to the best of their knowledge.
 2. Adopt a resolution, as it is worded in the Exhibit F of the FY 2024 CDBG application, the Village of Montgomery supports title VIII of the civil rights act of 1968 (Federal Housing Law) and the New York human rights law.
 3. Consider accepting the 2001 International TYMCO 600, Street Sweeper from the East Coast Industrial Services, Inc. at no cost to the Village of Montgomery.
 4. Surplus the following DPW equipment and vehicle:
 - a. 1996 Woodchuck chipper,
 - b. 2001 GMC,
 - c. Cab for New Holland Tractor,
 - d. Assorted Fire Hydrants
 5. Authorize the Village to enter into a contract with Auctions International for those occasions when the Village wants to sell surplus property.
 6. Approve the new pricing for the Dell Technologies, (Office 365), of \$302.40 for an overall total of \$7,16760, for 30 work stations, for the Village of Montgomery Police Department and the Village Hall, Clerk’s offices.
 7. Consider approving the Holy Name of Mary-Assumption request to host a procession of the Blessed Sacrament under a canopy with the parishioners of the parish following behind the canopy, singing hymns, through the Village on their Feast Day of Corpus Christi, on June 11, 2023, beginning at 9:15 am. The route begins on Route 211 toward Clinton Street, turning left onto Clinton Street, then a left onto Bridge Street to the end, turning a left onto Bachelor Street, and then a right onto Union Street, back to the Church. (There will be no stops along the way) and with the proper certificate of insurance provided, listing the Village as the additional insurer.
 8. Hire the 2023 Summer Recreation staff as the Recreation Director has outlined, beginning June 26th through August 4th, at 9:00 am to 4:00 pm, AM care starting at 7:45 am, and with no camp on July 4, 2023 -
 - a) Health Supervisor (RN) Yamileth Ruiz at \$34.00/hr., b) Activities Coordinator/Senior Counselor/Morning Supervisor, Justin Campbell at \$20.00/hr., c) Nurse, 3rd Yr. Student, Alexis Faia #24.00/hr., d) 19 Counselors at various rates starting at \$15.00 to \$16.00/hr., and e) 10 Counselors in training (volunteers).
 9. Adopt a resolution of the Board of Trustees, of the Village of Montgomery, authorizing the Mayor/or designee to renew, renew and amend, and/or execute a new three-year cooperative agreement between the County of Orange and the Municipality to participate in the Orange County Community Development Block Grant, Home Investment Partnership programs, and Emergency solutions grant program for Federal Fiscal Years 2024, 2025, and 2026 (and Successive three-year qualification periods), pursuant to title 1 of the Housing Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, the Cranston Gonzalez National Affordable Housing Act of 1990, as amended and subtitled B of Title IV of the McKinney-Vento homeless assistance act of 1987, as amended.
 10. Consider adopting an Inter-Municipal Agreement (IMA) with the Town Re: Town/Village Water Waste Treatment Plant MOU.
